The Board of Directors of the Forest View Acres Water District, El Paso County, Colorado, held a special meeting at the offices of the Monument Sanitation District, 130 2nd Street, Monument, Colorado, on Wednesday, December 6, 2023, at 6:00 p.m.

Present were the following members of the Board:

David Pheteplace, President P.K. Robinson, D Nancy Wilkins, Director Paul McKean, Director Matt Quinlan, Director Gregory Hoffman, Director

Vince Guthrie, Board Treasurer, was absent.

Also present were:

Joel Meggers; Community Resource Services of Colorado, LLC Molly Couture; Community Resource Services of Colorado, LLC Peter Johnson; Vranesh and Raisch, LLP Gabby Begeman; ORC Water Professionals Mike Waresak, Forsgren Associates, Inc.

Mr. Meggers stated that proper publication was made to conduct a public hearing on the District's 2024 budget. The President opened the public hearing on the District's proposed 2024 budget. There was no public comment on the District's budget, the public hearing was closed.

Thereupon, Director Wilkins introduced and moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION SUMMARIZING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR EACH FUND, ADOPTING A BUDGET, LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2021 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT, AND APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO THE VARIOUS FUNDS IN THE AMOUNTS AND FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH HEREIN FOR THE FOREST VIEW ACRES WATER DISTRICT, EL PASO COUNTY, COLORADO, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY 2024, AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER 2024.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Forest View Acres Water District has authorized its consultants to prepare and submit a proposed budget to said governing body no later than October 15, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the proposed 2024 budget has been submitted to the Board of Directors of the District for its consideration; and

WHEREAS, upon due and proper notice, published on October 19, 2023 in a newspaper having general circulation within the boundaries of the District, pursuant to statute, said proposed budget was available for inspection by the public at a designated public office, a public hearing was held on October 25, 2023 and interested electors were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues or planned to be expended from reserves of fund balances so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$96,202 and

WHEREAS, the 2023 valuation for assessment for the District as certified by the County Assessor for El Paso County is \$19,240,490.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE FOREST VIEW ACRES WATER DISTRICT, EL PASO COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. <u>2024 Budget Revenues</u>. That the estimated revenues for each fund as more specifically set out in the budget attached hereto are accepted and approved.

Section 2. <u>2024 Budget Expenditures</u>. That the estimated expenditures for each fund as more specifically set out in the budget attached hereto are accepted and approved.

Section 3. <u>Adoption of Budget for 2024.</u> That the budget as submitted, and attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, and if amended, then as amended, is hereby approved and adopted by the Board of Directors as the true and accurate budget of the Forest View Acres Water District for calendar year 2024.

Section 4. <u>Levy of General Property Taxes.</u> That the Board of Directors does hereby certify the levy of general property taxes for collection in 2023 as follows:

A. <u>Levy for General Operating Fund Expenses</u>. That for the purposes of meeting all general operating expense of the District during the 2024 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 5.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2023.

Section 5. <u>Property Tax and Fiscal Year Spending Limits</u>. That, being fully informed, the Board finds that the foregoing budget and mill levies do not result in a violation of any applicable property tax or fiscal year spending limitation.

Section 6. <u>Certification</u>. The District's manager is hereby authorized and directed to certify by December 15, 2023, to the Board of County Commissioners of El Paso County, Colorado, the mill levies for the District herein above determined and set, or be authorized and directed to certify to the Board of County Commissioners of El Paso County, Colorado, as herein above determined and set, but as recalculated as needed upon receipt of the final certification of valuation from the County Assessor on or about December 10, 2023, in order to comply with any applicable revenue and other budgetary limits or to implement the intent of the District. That said certification shall be in substantially the form set out and attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 7. <u>Appropriations</u>. That the amounts set forth as expenditures and balances remaining, as specifically allocated in the budget attached hereto, are hereby appropriated from the revenue of each fund, to each fund, for the purposes stated and no other.

The foregoing Resolution was seconded by Director McKean.

### FOREST VIEW ACRES WATER DISTRICT 2024 BUDGET SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ASSUMPTIONS

#### Introduction

The District was organized in 1956 to provide water service to property within its service area.

The District serves approximately 275 households and is located entirely within the boundaries of El Paso County. Existing development within the District consists primarily of residential housing.

The 2024 Budget of the Forest View Acres Water District is prepared using a modified accrual basis of accounting.

The Board of Directors acknowledges the adoption of the TABOR Amendment on November 3, 1992 and has attempted to comply within the spirit of the TABOR Amendment as best as possible given the ambiguities which exist in interpreting its provisions.

At a special election held on November 7, 2006, the qualified electors of the District approved the imposition of a general fund mill levy not in excess of five (5) mills annually for the purpose of paying the District's operations, maintenance, and other expenses.

#### REVENUE

<u>General Fund</u>: The primary source of revenue for general operations in 2024 are property taxes, specific ownership taxes and interest income. For tax year 2024, the District adopted a mill levy of 5.000 mills, yielding \$96,201 in property taxes.

Operations Fund: The District has established an Operations Fund for water and sewer operations. Service charges and use fees are billed to all connected taps on a monthly basis.

<u>Capital Improvements Fund</u>: The primary source of revenue for capital improvements are tap fees, capital replacement fees, and availability of service charges.

#### EXPENDITURES

<u>General Fund</u>: The District's expenditures for general administrative services are based upon the same level of service as the current and prior years.

<u>Operations Fund</u>: Water and sewer operations are contained within this fund. Revenues and expenditures are based upon a similar level of service as the current and prior years.

<u>Capital Improvements Fund</u>: The District has a loan with the Colorado Water and Power Development Authority. The 2024 principal payment is \$130,986 and the interest amount due is \$7,651.

Emergency Reserve: The District has provided for an Emergency Reserve in the amount of 3% of the total expenditures in the General Fund in accordance with the TABOR Amendment.

Leases: The District has no leases.
